Performance highlights for the Quarter

NEMA undertook review of 462 ESIAs with in the quarter. The Authority carried out 193 environment compliance and audit inspections in the FY2023-24, quarter 1.

The Oil Gas sector being in high production stages, the Authority has undertaken Monitoring and Supervision, and coordination activities for effective management of the environmental aspects of Oil and Gas in the country and particularly the biodiversity Rich Albertine Graben

One regulation (Noise and Vibrations regulations) has been reviewed for finalization in partnership with development partners under the Oil for Development Programme

The Legal department alongside the Environmental Protection Force and the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions is handling 110 cases that have emerged out of violation of the National Environment Act 2019 and the attendant regulations

The Intelligence unit of the Authority carried out Environmental Crime Intelligence and Information gathering to support enforcement operation and prosecutions. 31 intelligence information gathering undertakings were done on noncompliance to environmental laws, regulations, and standards The EPF carried out 7 operations ranging from surveillance, intelligence led operations, investigations, providing enforcement related support in noise pollution control, responding to alerts of degradation of wetland/lakeshore, community policing, enforcement of restoration orders, identification of violators of the NEA, 2019 and specifically EIA conditions of approval, and other related non-compliance activities. In total EPF carried out 447 actions

The Authority undertook a partnership Engagement with Jane Goodall Institute and Kikuube District Local Government on effective management and restoration of ecosystems, particularly under the restoration of Kikuube Mixed Land Use Area Project. It also signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Makerere University to enhance research network between the two institutions

Variances and Challenges

The major challenge NEMA is facing is lack of Environmental Monitoring Equipment,. including fleet. NEMA is also challenged with increasing degradation incidences that require more enforcement capacities, which are lacking due to no recruitment of the Environment Protection Force. The Inadequate funding also posses challenges to the institution to enable it undertake activities and foster sustainable development
