75 hectares of plantations were established in Lendu plantations while 537.5 hectares were weeded by slash in the plantations of Mwenge (85), South Busoga (100) and Lendu (100) and in the natural forests of Kyoga (65); Muzizi (104) and Lakeshore (82.5 ha).

75 hectares were maintained by pruning in Mbarara and 322 hectares thinned in Mwenge (86), Mbarara (100), South Busoga (100) and Lendu (36)
