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Performance highlights for the Quarter

A total of 1,193,345 hectares equivalent to 94.38% of the total Central Forest Reserve (CFR) area of 1,265,000 hectares were protected from illegal activities and encroachment across the country through forest law enforcement patrols supported by the environmental Protection Police in 16 management areas across the country (7 plantation management – Mbarara, Mafuga, Mwenge, Lendu, Opit-Abera, Katuugo, and South Busoga areas and 9 Ranges of Achwa, Karamoja, Kyoga, Lake shore, Sango Bay, South West, Muzizi, Budongo System, and West Nile). A total of 2,845 tourists visited the ecotourism sites with 1,408 males and 1,437 females. 1,576 Eco tourists visited Kaniyo-Pabid ecosite; 1,256 Eco tourists visited Kalinzu ecosite; 7 ecotourists visited Bugoma ecosite; while 6 ecotourists visited Echuya ecosite. 37 kilo meters of firelines were maintained in Q1 with 35 km in Kagombe CFR in Budongo Systems Range, 1 Km in Towa CFR, and 1 Km Mugoye CFR - Sango Bay range. 130 KM of boundary were resurveyed and marked with pillars while 1,072 ha were freed from encroachment and protected. 930.0 ha of degraded CFRs were restored, 25 ha of commercial tree plantations were maintained under NFA with survival above 70 per cent while 7,042 ha of plantations were protected from fires. 5,379,087 assorted seedlings were supplied in the quarter while a total of 2,336 kg of seeds were supplied with 2,330.37 kg of assorted seeds and 6.05 Kg of Bamboo seeds supplied by the National Tree Seed center. The external financing for 1613 was still being configured on IFMIS and so it does not reflect in the financial performance. In Q1, UGX 12.3 Billion was released as external financing of which UGX 0.841 billion was spent.

Variances and Challenges

Inadequate funds for implementation of planned activities in the quarter like boundary surveying, seedlings production and opening of forest management roads within the Central Forest Reserves (CFRs). Illegal land titles, land claims and court injunctions that delay implementation of activities and increase damage caused by encroachers to the reserve due to unfair injunctions. Inadequate transport facilities (vehicles/motorcycles), old fleet and inadequate fuel for field operations, inspections and enforcement.
