Performance highlights for the Quarter

During Quarter one, FY 2022/23, a total of 1.987 million bags valued at USD 211.691 million were exported compared to 1.586 million bags valued at USD 227.649 million representing a decrease in export by 20% and an increase in value by 7.07%. However during the same quarter coffee production was at 1.8 million bags compared to 2.1 million bags in the same period last FY 2021/22. The reduction in coffee production was by 300,000 bags and this was mainly due to drought which affected the production. Additionally, it is an off production year which is about 10%.

Key output performance highlights:

i) Conducted 228 farmer trainings reaching 6,325 (4,366M,1959F,713Y)

ii) Conducted 624 farm visits to 2,727 (2182M, 545F, 284Y)

iii) Distributed 34,400 CWDR plantlets in Northern Uganda for establishment of both demo gardens and mother gardens benefiting 23 farmers (20M,3F)

iv) 216 factories and stores were registered

v) Held 39 Radio talk shows in different radio stations in Western region as follows

Vi) Inspected 1,580,167bags (60 kgs) for export to various global destinations (Arabica – 132,593bags and Robusta – 1,447,574 bags)

Vii) Conducted 4 quality monitoring and supervision missions in Mt. Rwenzori region, Kigezi region, Busoga region and West Nile (Zombo district).

vii) Conducted the "Best of the Pearl" Robusta competition in collaboration with UCF

ix) Promoted coffee consumption at 10 local including the 28th National Agricultural show in Jinja, and at the PPDA Business Expo in Kololo.

x) Conducted 01 Quality sensitization and enforcement mission in Rwenzori Region Kasese district. (07 stores and 02 primary processing factories sealed off due to non-conformance to National Coffee Act)

xi) Conducted 2 capacity building stakeholder trainings in the National Coffee Law.

xii) Stock verification was done at exporter level. A total of 957,077 60 kg bags of coffee were recorded stocks at exporter level by 30th June 2022.

Matters to note in budget execution

Coffee Production and Productivity challenges:

i) Inflation effects: Increased fuel and commodity prices attributed to the Russia – Ukraine war and COVID-19 pandemic greatly affected activity implementation in many aspects.

ii) Pest and Diseases incidences: There is an increased incidence of Root Mealybugs and Coffee Berry Disease in Elgon region; Red Blister and BCTB in Eastern Region. The increased incidences are linked to failure by farmers to adopt GAPs.

iii) Natural disasters: The Floods experienced in Elgon and Rwenzori greatly affected coffee farmers and their farms. Soils were washed and crops lost let alone some farmers losing their lives.

iv) Uncertainty on coffee plantlets distribution for Aug– Nov 2022 season: Generally, there was overwhelming pressure and demand from coffee farmers who were mobilized earlier to prepare for the August - November 2022 coffee planting season. The Government of Uganda changed strategy of providing coffee seedlings to farmers through the Parish Development Models.

v) Insufficient funds: The funds released for Q1 were not sufficient to fully fund the operations of the field teams. As a result, mileage for September and August was not fully paid thereby affecting implementation of field operations for the quarter. As a result, many activities for first quarter were deferred to second quarter with the hope that funds will be released as planned.

Coffee Quality, Value Addition and Market Promotion challenges:

i) The quality of coffee is still affected with defects for instance the Robusta (Busoga) had high percentage of chalky whites and discolored beans; adulteration of Robusta with Arabica especially in Rwenzori region and low outturn.

- ii) Shortage of containers is presenting a logistical challenge for export business of coffee in regards to coffee movement
- iii) Limited space of Lugogo laboratories to handle increased export samples
- iv) Inadequate funding for key activities and budget cuts on the approved budget
