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Performance highlights for the Quarter

The Embassy coordinated the official visit by Hon. Gen. Wilson Mbadi, Minister of State for Trade from the Ministry of Trade Industry and Cooperatives (MTIC), Uganda. He came to Turkiye to attend the Third Ministerial Meeting of the TPS-OIC Trade Negotiation Committee held in Istanbul on 11 June, 2024.

The Embassy participated in the Izmir Coffee Expo that attracted Turkish as well as Balkans, Caucasus, Middle East and Mediterranean Green Coffee bean importers, roasters and retailers. The Embassy exhibited varieties of roasted Uganda coffee and hired services of a Barister to serve Uganda coffee for the entire duration of the exhibition.

The Embassy was supported by Uganda Coffee Development Authority which sent a delegation of four (4) technical officers that carried out coffee cupping and tasting sessions at the exhibition.
