Performance highlights for the Quarter

- -The Embassy supported Ugandans in distress particularly those arrested by Turkish Authorities for overstay as well as supporting Ugandan patients who travel for medical treatment to different hospitals.

Variances and Challenges

- -Rotation of officers in Q1 had impact in advancement of planned activities during the transition period.
- -Ongoing rise in inflation distorts prices and negatively affects the cost of living.
- -Inadequate and obsolete office equipment such as computers and printers. There is need for a capital budget to acquire such equipment.
- -The Embassy lacks adequate transport in form of cars. The size of Turkey as a country is vast and the distances the Embassy covers by road are long. It is important that the Embassy fleet is enhanced.
