Variances and Challenges

- 1. Insufficient funds to fund labor related activities and Consular services which are part of the core mandate of the embassy. These activities require travelling by road from Abu Dhabi to the six emirates.
- 2. Lack of a dedicated Labor attaché to handle labor issues
- 3. High increase of forged documents presented for attestation
- 4. Reluctance of Ugandans in the UAE to register with the embassy.
- 5. The Embassy doesnot have its own Chancery premises and therefore incurs high costs on rent.
- 6. High operational costs for the rescue accommodations yet on average the embassy receives 10 distressed Ugandan domestic workers seeking assistance though the number is even higher in Dubai. The rescue accommodation requires operational funds to cater for utilities like water, electricity for cooling, lighting and cooking, welfare while at the facility to include meals, sanitary supplies and medical care. The facility also requires a full-time staff to cook, clean and manage the admission and exit of the distressed domestic workers from the facility.
- 7. Medical expenses It is required in UAE that staff are covered under the National Health Medical Insurance Scheme. Currently the embassy can only afford a basic package for local staff which is doesn't provide 100% coverage.
- 8. Uganda Embassy in Abu Dhabi and the Consulate in Dubai experiences extremely hot conditions which increases the cost of cooling residential accommodation and offices, exposes staff to adverse health conditions arising from extreme heat and increases the cost of living
- 9. The Consulate requires a utility van to support the Consular services especially going to prisons, and hospitals and executing rescue operations. This can also used to facilitate transits, and airport pick ups.
- 10. Dubai is transit airport for most of the VVIPs, this implies they require VIP services during transit. The embassy staff are overwhelmed while facilitating these transits for entitled persons since it requires travel to Dubai.
