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#### Performance highlights for the Quarter

Public awareness on weather and climate issues raised through 7 radio talk shows on radio one, KFM,CBS (2), Messiah(Kasese), Voice of Toro(Kabarole), Grace radio(Mbarara) and 1 TV talkshow on NTV.

Printed the June-August seasonal forecast in the new vision to disseminate the forecast.

Draft Aeronautical cost recovery regulations for provision of meteorological services have been pending consideration by UNMA top Management. Two seasonal climate outlooks (March-May and June-August) were issued for central, eastern, northern and western regions with advisories to particular climatological zones.

Conducted 6 radio talk shows to disseminate the issued seasonal forecast and generate feedback on utilisation of meteorological forecasts.

Disseminated the June-August seasonal forecast through telegram, USSD code and a page pullout in the new-vision.

546 Terminal Aerodrome Forecasts, 27 SIGMETs and 3,861 Flight folders issued for Entebbe and Soroti; 13,104 METARs issued from 11 synoptic stations of Gulu, Masindi, Mbarara, Makerere, Kasese, Soroti, Lira, Kabale, Jinja, Entebbe and Tororo.

Daily forecasts disseminated to 4 media houses of UBC TV, Star TV, Bukedde TV 1 after the newscasts in Luganda, Swahili and English.

Provided 184 Lake Victoria marine forecasts for the four regions of Lake Victoria.

54 Rainfall Stations, 60 ADCON Automatic Weather Stations and 38 manual weather stations were maintained functional across the country. Rehabilitated stations of Tororo, Buginyanya, Kanungu, Ntungamo and Mukongoro (Kumi)

1 Automatic Weather Station (AWS) was installed at Bundibugyo, 1 Automatic Weather Station was installed at Buvuma island in Buvuma district and the hydromet station at Butiaba was upgraded from Manual to an Automatic Weather Station

Calibration was undertaken for 20 Atmospheric Barometers, 20 Air thermometers at 20 Weather stations

One (1) customer satisfaction survey on provision aeronautical meteorological services was conducted in Kasese and Entebbe.

#### **Variances and Challenges**

The following are the major reasons for variance:

Through Mercycorps, 3 DAVIS Automatic Weather Stations were installed in Amudat (1), Kotido (1) and Kaabong(1).

No funds were availed for improving functionality for 15 RIKA and 10 DAVIS AWS stations; procurement of corobor system and Automatic Weather Observing Station at Pakuba.

No funds were availed for construction of the Radar Operation center at Kigungu, construction of the pit latrines of Ntusi and Kibanda and fencing of the Kigungu radar site.
