### Performance highlights for the Quarter

The following were achieved during the reporting period:

One seasonal climate outlook December-February were issued on for central, eastern, northern and western regions with advisories to particular climatological zones

National Rainfall outlook was developed and disseminated at Uganda Media Centre where a network of media houses received and further disseminated to various users of climate information; The talk-shows were held in Voice of Muhabura in Kisoro, Vision Radio in Mbarara, Voice of Kamwenge, Voice of Toro, Britop FM in Kyegegwa, Spice FM in Hoima, Ateker and Akica FM in Moroto and Heritage FM in Nakapiripirit districts National Meteorological Training School was facilitated to provide conducive educational facilities and held the 4th graduation ceremony which was presided over by the Minister of State for Higher Education Dr. J.C. Muyingo where more than 300 students were awarded Diplomas and Certificates. 8 media activities were carried out across the country especially on local/community. Radios and TVs and also print media: 1 at UBC TV, 1 at NTV, 1 at NBS TV, 1 at CBS,

5 radio programs were carried out; 1 at KFM, 1 at CBS FM, 1 Mbarara Grace Radio and 1 NBS Kodeyo radio. Being a rainfall season, there were 4 stories in the New Vision and 3 in the Daily Monitor.

New automatic Weather station in Lamwo District was installed.

Completed Calibration of weather instruments for 10 thermometers and 3 barometers.

546 Terminal Aerodrome Forecasts, 810 SIGMETs and 17472 METARs and 4.309 Flight folders were issued for Entebbe and Soroti (operating 24hrs); Gulu, Arua, Kasese, Kajjasi, Kabaale, Jinja and Tororo (operating 12hours) Aerodromes.

Daily forecasts were disseminated to 3 media houses of UBC TV, Star TV, Bukedde 1 T.V after the newscasts in Luganda, Swahili and English Radar and Windshear Operations were maintained at Lira, Rwampara and Entebbe through payment for guard and security services and utilities.

### Variances and Challenges

The following are the major reasons for variation:

The Terminal Aerodrome Forecasts and METAR figures look the same because the observations are routinely scheduled with-in specific periods, apart from the flight folders. The SIGMETs increased in number due to the rainy season that dominated our flight information region (Uganda air space).

Because of the urgent need for the low level windshear alerting system arising from the International Civil Aviation Authority (ICAO) audit on UCAA and UNMA and complaints from pilots regarding wind variations during approach /landing and takeoff, funds meant for Light ICT hardware, Non-residential buildings, other Machinery and equipment and Other ICT equipment were spent to top-up the Letter of credit for the procurement of the windshear alerting system which was grossly underfunded.
