Performance highlights for the Quarter

By Q4 the Fund had received 100.00% of the appropriated fund for the year 2022/23 and allocated toward maintenance of National and District Urban and Community Access Roads maintenance and Secretariat operation. Most of the planned activities were implemented except some maintenance on national roads under Framework contracts where funds were used to pay existing outstanding debts.

In KCCA, maintenance plans were not implemented 100.00% as most substantial budget was used to address increased pothole patching due to more failures on aged paved roads.

Variances and Challenges

In Q4 the Fund received release of UGX140.211bn inclusive of UGX2.237bn for secretariat operational costs. this is equivalent to 28.73% of the annual budget. Cumulatively the Fund has received through quarterly releases a total sum of UGX487.952bn which translates to 100.00% of the budget appropriated to Uganda Road Fund.

However, during the period, heavy rainfall was registered in most parts of the country that washed away most roads and bridges that had to be attended to urgently. this distorted the implementation of workplan. in addition, lack of adequate equipment still remains a challenge to timely implementation of road maintenance works.
