#### I. VOTE MISSION STATEMENT

To conduct scientific investigations on diseases, contribute to knowledge, policy and practice; and engage in capacity development for improved public health.

#### II. STRATEGIC OBJECTIVE

To improve population health, safety and management.

#### III. MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2023/24

Influenza Surveillance was carried out and of the 530 samples collected, 36 were positive for COVID 19, 16 positives for Influenza A (H3), 16 positives for Pandemic Influenza A (H1) 2009 and 8 positives for Influenza B.

Mosquitoes and ticks were collected in for arboviruses surveillance activities to determine the different pathogens that spread to humans.

Responded to Rift Valley outbreak in Mbarara.

The Institutes Clinic provided medical care to people in Entebbe and surrounding areas.

One field sampling in Eastern region was carried out to establish arboviral and malaria vector species including An Gambiae culex mosquitoes Anopheles mosquitoe and Aedes simpsoni species.

Screening for bacterial endosymbionts pathogenic insect virus and fungal isolates in mosquito vector populations done and it is evident from larva collected that Aedes simpsoni (yellow fever vector) was more widely distributed than previously thought.

Environmental surveillance of suspected poliovirus carried out and 99% Virus isolation results were timely reported to stakeholders

Continued Covid 19 Vaccination at the institute clinic.

Responded to the Anthrax outbreak in Bududa and Kween districts.

Evaluated new diagnostic tools for viral diseases to be used among the population and all targeted testers provided with External Quality Assurance (EQA) materials.

A total of 2036 Acute Flaccid paralysis (AFP) stool samples were received from Uganda and across the region and processed on time.

Responded to suspected measles and congenital rubella syndrome out breaks.

Continued with research on vaccine preventable diseases including COVID 19.

Conducted COVID 19 impact on Structural Determinants and Social Transitions among Adolescent in Rakai and surrounding districts.

Testing Viruses sensitivity to Monoclonal Antibodies(mabs) carried out involving several activities which included Single cell sorting Rapid Assembly Transfection and production of Immunoglobulins Single cell germline sequencing using the 10X genomics platform.

#### **Vote Challenges**

- \*Inadequate office and laboratory space.
- \*Inadequate staffing in some departments.
- \*There is inadequate funding for UVRI especially for research reagents which constrains the delivery of its mandate and mission.
- \*There is currently no centralized and accessible sample repository system, which has constrained proper sample management and utilization
- \*There is inadequate dissemination and utilization of its research findings which constrains its contribution to evidence-based policy formulation and practice.
- \*There is inadequate transport, especially sample collection vehicle.
- \*Lack of funds to pay off squatters from the institute land.
- \*Old laboratory vehicles for field activities and day to day laboratory activities led to high maintenance costs and late implementation of planned activities.
- \*Shortage of some laboratory reagents led to delayed lab testing.
- \*The votes budget has kept dwindling and this was greatly influenced by the LGBTQ law in Uganda.
- \*Load shedding has resulted into very high operational cost of using the 500kva generator which consumes about 5m on a day.

#### Plans to improve Vote Performance

One old formerly a residential house was renovated and will be equipped next financial year to create more office space.

The accounting officer has written to MOFPED requesting for more funding to recruit staff, procure more reagents and smooth operation of the institute.

The available sample reception will be equipped and functional if retooling funds are availed to the vote.

There a plan to increase on the UVRI publicity come next financial year and one assistant director has been identified to spearhead this.

The vote has written both to MOFPED and Parliament to address the issue of squatters on the kamwanyi land.

Plan to enhance collaborative partnerships between UVRI and other training Institutions.

Increase awareness of science among the students.

Encourage exchange and sabbatical programs

Diversify donor funding by looking for more friendly countries who could be anti LGBTQ.

Construct a science block to house laboratories offices stores and a conference facility (At feasibility level).
